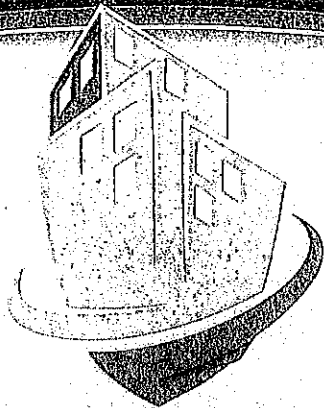
Post Abortion Recovery
