BLACK MUSIC MONTH

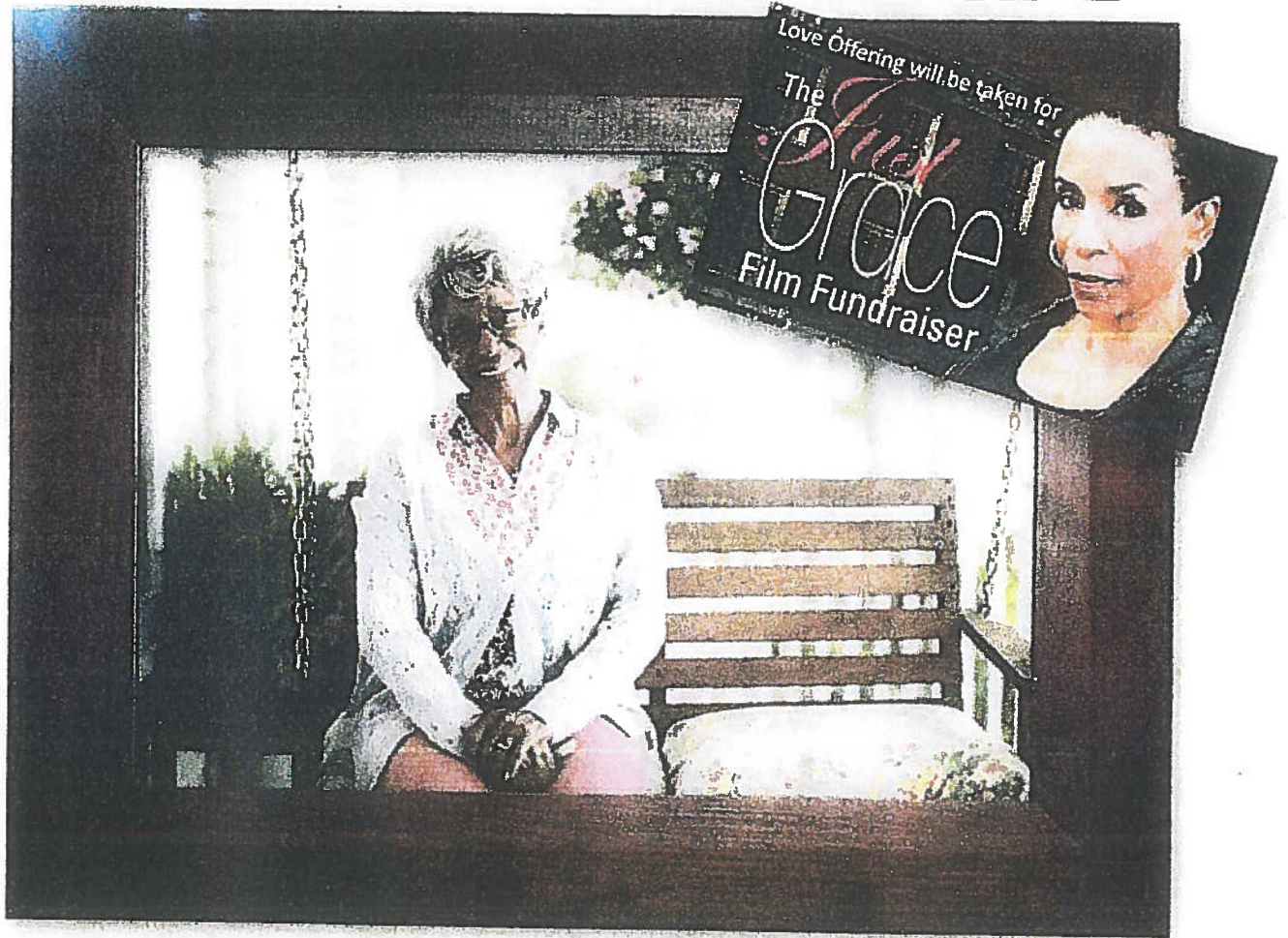
