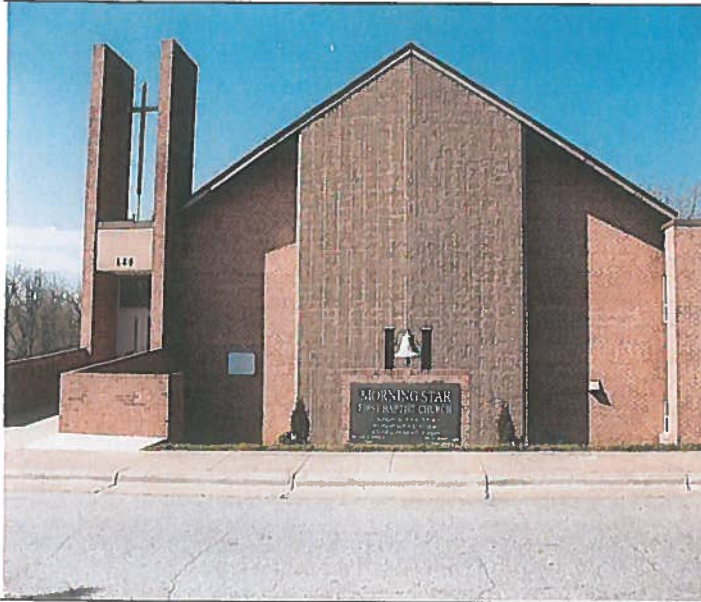

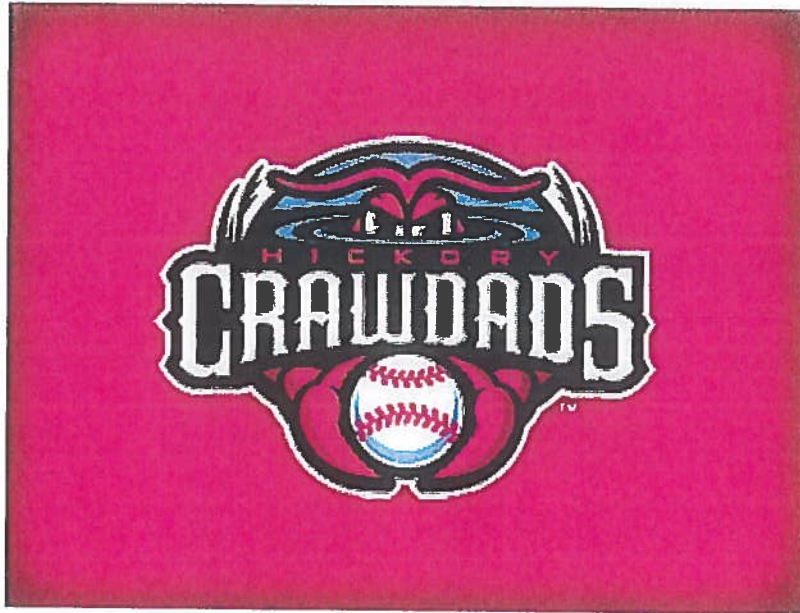



We thank you in advance for your continued support and ask that you reply to us with your commitment **no later Friday, June 29** so that we will be able to properly have your table assigned and designated for you.

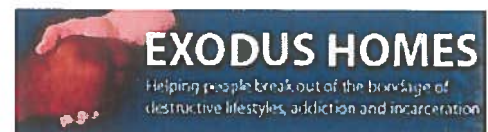
