Join us for an evening of prayer, worship and inspiration with local area churches at Moretz Mills, 74 8th Street SE Hickory, NC

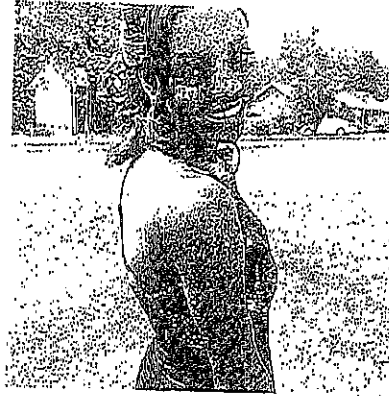
